Dear Neighbors:

BGI/Nibbi will be requesting the approval of a special Night Noise permit from the Department of Building Inspection.

The request is being made in order to place a large monolithic concrete pour at the Alice Griffith Block 1 project on Arelious Walker Drive and Carroll Avenue from the extended hours of 6:00am to 7:00am on October 28th, 2016.

The purpose of the extended hour's concrete pour is to facilitate the monolithic podium deck pour which will consist of 1,100 cubic yards of concrete. This volume of concrete will involve 110 concrete delivery trucks which will need to have minimal traffic impact to ensure that the rate of concrete being placed does not affect the structural integrity of the podium deck.

We will do our best to avoid any disruption and keep noise to a very minimum.

Pursuant to provisions of Section 2907 and 2908 of Ordinance No. 274-72 the Director of Building Inspection has determined that the kind of work to be done may generate noise that causes significant disturbance during the permit hours. The work may cause less traffic and safety problems at night than during daytime. Therefore being in the general public interest hereby grants permission revocable at his will for **concrete podium deck pour at Arellious Walker and Carroll Avenue.**

- > **This permit shall be valid for October 28, 2016.**
- > **Hours: 6:00 AM to 7:00 AM**
- > **Equipment List: Concrete delivery trucks, 2 concrete pumps, concrete vibration equipment and light towers (lights to be direct into the site and away from any of the surrounding buildings).**
- > **All significant equipment shall be provided with proper mufflers and acoustical shrouds.**
- > **Excessive noise from handling tools and loud conversation shall be held at minimum.**
- > **All other required permits shall be obtained.**

The permittee, by acceptance of this permit, agrees to indemnify, hold harmless, and assume the defense of the City and County of San Francisco from and against any and all claims, demands, and actions for damages resulting from operations under this permit, regardless of negligence of the City and County of San Francisco.

The permittee, by acceptance of this permit, agrees to compensate the City and County of San Francisco in full for all damage to property of the City and County of San Francisco, or to public property under its jurisdiction resulting from operations under this permit, regardless of negligence of the City and County of San Francisco.
